If you fear that yourself or a loved one may be financially exploited – whether this be by a family member, fiduciary, professional advisor or a complete stranger – you can reach out to us to make sure that your accounts are secure, and we can direct you to the appropriate agency to assist you in investigating the situation. You can also contact the Missouri Department of Senior Services, that has a team of social workers specifically dedicated to stopping elder abuse or exploitation.

# RED FLAGS OF FINANCIAL EXPLOITATION



1. Changes in legal documents/estate plan at the request or pressure of another.

- 2. Unpaid bills by fiduciary.
- 3. Missing valuables.

4. Unintended or unexplained use of debit card, checks or credit card.


5. Being isolated from other friends and family members by a caregiver or friend.

6. Being pressured to make quick decisions and not tell others about them.

7. Caregiver that is no longer meeting your basic needs of health and hygiene.

8. Friends, caregivers or family members with new, likely excessive, interest in your finances.

To identify these red flags, you should review your bank statements and bills regularly, and stay in contact with trusted family members and friends, being open and honest with them about your concerns.
