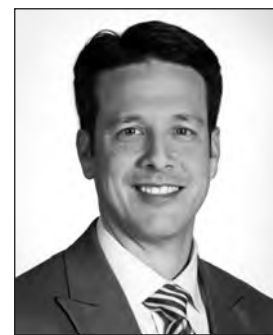
Meet our New Financial Advisor....Jason B. Dickinson
