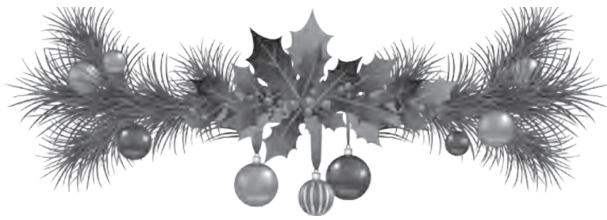

TACO SALAD FOR A CROWD

INGREDIENTS

- 1-1/2 lbs. ground beef
- 2 envelopes taco seasoning, divided
- 1 medium head iceberg lettuce
- 1 package (10 oz.) nacho-flavored tortilla chips, coarsely crushed
- 2 pints grape tomatoes, halved
- 2 cans (16 oz. ea.) kidney beans, rinsed & drained
- 3 cans (2-1/4 oz. ea.) sliced ripe olives, drained
- 1-1/2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 large sweet onion, chopped
- 2 cans (4 oz. ea.) chopped green chilies
- 1-1/2 cups Thousand Island salad dressing
- 1-1/3 cups salsa
- 1/3 cup sugar

DIRECTIONS

Over medium heat, cook beef with 1 envelope plus 2 tablespoons taco seasoning until no longer pink; drain. In a very large serving bowl, combine the lettuce, chips, tomatoes, beans, olives, cheese, onion, chilies & beef mixture. In a small bowl, combine the salad dressing, salsa, sugar & remaining taco seasoning; pour over salad and toss to coat.
